

Bashaer F1



Type:

A hybrid suited for use in the fresh market. Bashaer is an early maturing variety that produces firm fruits

Nursery period:

3-4 weeks.

Maturity:

75 days after transplanting.

Plant:

Determinate, very vigorous, good cover and high yielding

Fruit:

Very firm elongated, non-green back, smooth and firm oval fruits with an average fruit weight of 130gms.

Production/Yield:

30-35 tons/acre concentrated picking under good agricultural practices.

Shelf life:

Over 21 days.

Disease tolerance:

- Verticillium & Fusarium Wilt (race 1 and 2);
- Tobacco Mosaic Virus (TMV: 0)
- Tomato Mosaic Virus (ToMV: 0-2)

10,000 plants per acre
